How to Get CUPE 2626 Privileges

As a member of CUPE 2626, you are entitled to several privileges. Here's how to take advantage of them!

Weekend Parking Pass: All employees (TAs, RAs, Markers, Proctors, Demonstrators, Lab Monitors and Tutors) can get a university parking pass for weekends and holidays for FREE during the semesters you are employed!
How? Show your CUPE 2626 sticker or contract to Parking Services, at 139 Louis-Pasteur, room 133, and ask for a weekend parking pass. (See article 28.1.6 of your Collective Agreement)

Software License: TAs and RAs can purchase software under the university's Microsoft License. You can get Microsoft Office for less than \$15 with this employee discount, instead of \$95 with the student discount!
How? Show your CUPE 2626 sticker or contract to the University Bookstore (in UCU), and ask for the employee discount. (See article 28.1.4 of your Collective Agreement)

As a member of CUPE 2626, you also might be eligible for:

- Financial Aid Fund
- Conference Fund
- Tuition Support Bursary
- University Dental Plan

The GA of November 4th passed a number of bylaw revisions changing the structure of the Executive Board and the election procedure for the five senior Executive positions. The new Executive Board structure is as follows:

GATINEAU— Striking workers from the Museum of Civilization and War Museum voted overwhelmingly to reject a final offer from the Canadian Museum of Civilization Corporation this evening, at a membership meeting in Gatineau. Hundreds attended the meeting, voting to reject the offer by a margin of 96 per cent. [cited from press release]

The new election process is as follows:

- The five senior positions are: President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, and the two Chief Stewards. Elections for these positions will now be done in a multi-week campaign, with a week of ballot voting at the CUPE 2626 office (UCU 303), and additional voting stations in the UniCentre and at Roger-Guindon during two days.

- The five junior positions (Equity Officer, Health & Safety Officer, Recording Secretary, and the two Officers Without Portfolio) will continue to be elected at the winter GA.

Bylaw Revisions Committee

In the wake of our recent GA, there were informal requests by a number of members for a Special GA to exclusively address the issue of the linguistic requirements for elected positions. The Bylaw Revisions Committee (BRC) is making preparations to respond promptly and effectively to any such formal petition from the membership.

In that regard, the BRC will use the power granted to it by the GA to consolidate all of the linguistic requirements for elected positions into a single article in our bylaws so that the issue can be addressed more easily and transparently. Given that bylaw revisions must be announced at least 60 days in advance of a GA, it would not be feasible to hold a Special GA prior to February.

As such, if a petition for a Special GA were received prior to **December 18th**, efforts would be made to organise a Special General Assembly concurrent with our elections for Senior Executive Officers.
